Transurban makes global sustainability index for 5th year in row

For the fifth consecutive year, Transurban has earned international recognition with a listing in the Dow Jones Sustainability Indexes (DJSI) World list of high-performing companies.

The DJSI tracks the financial performance of the leading sustainability-driven companies worldwide. Each year, the index scores and ranks these businesses based on economic, environmental and social criteria and publishes the results in the DJSI World list. The 2010 list was announced in September.

This year 47 companies were assessed under the 'industrial transportation' sector. Of these, six – including Transurban – made the World list.

We were the only Australian-based company in this sector to be included. European toll road companies Abertis and Atlantia also made the list, along with FedEx and Deutsche Post.

Transurban's overall score improved by 2 per cent this year to 89. We now rank just 3 per cent behind our category's sector leader, TNT.

Our economic and environmental scores were the highest in our industry category, while our social score rose by 5 per cent.
