Another year serving local communities and driving the economy forward through investments in greater mobility and safety

Community investments

8,700 new jobs estimated for the region

\$1B estimated in economic activity

\$110M in contracts with disadvantaged businesses and small women- and minority-owned businesses

\$280K in community grants to 70+ local organizations pre- and post-opening

Driver mobility and safety

50% improved travel times for I-395 drivers and **18% fewer accidents** expected with the addition of a fourth lane between Duke Street and Edsall Road

3,400 sluggers and **1,800 buses** who can enjoy carpool benefits and more predictable travel in and around the Pentagon

Long-term commitment to the region

\$15M annually in transit payments from Transurban toward multi-modal improvements along I-95 and I-395, which is delivering:

700 additional riders moved through the corridor daily, saving **89,000** hours of daily travel per year

2.4M trips diverted to transit, taking **20.5 million passenger miles off** local roads

3,000 -metric ton reduction of Northern Virginia's greenhouse gas emissions each year
