## **Toll-Road Operator Transurban Expands Executive Team to Deliver Future Pipeline of P3 Toll Lanes in North America**

*New hires strengthen capacity to modernize infrastructure, create jobs and rebuild the economy*

**ALEXANDRIA, VA, September 8, 2020** – [Transurban](#), one of the world’s largest toll-road operators, today announced three new hires to serve on the North American leadership team to bolster the development, delivery and operations of its growing toll road portfolio in the U.S. and Canada.

Since 2012, the global toll operator has more than tripled its portfolio, expanding into five markets and now serving 8.8 million customers and road users annually. Transurban is progressing some of the largest road and tunnel projects in Australia including WestConnex and NorthConnex, while also advancing a multi-billion-dollar global pipeline of emerging opportunities to support governments and drive economic growth.

“Change is constant in this business, and we are fortunate to have great new leadership in front of us to support our North American capacity,” said Jennifer Aument, President, Transurban North America. “While we are being prudent during these uncertain economic times, we are also embracing the momentum we’ve created. We continue to be a strong ally to the government in delivering high-impact travel corridors that are putting people to work and keeping the economy moving.”

The latest hires to the Transurban North America team include:

- **Luis Palazzi.** Palazzi joins Transurban as Vice President of Development, responsible for growing Transurban’s pipeline of North American opportunities and advancing P3 projects through development and commercial execution. Palazzi brings more than 20 years of global infrastructure expertise – leading equity investments and managing a portfolio of assets across transportation, water and industrial sectors in North and Latin America. He brings his senior leadership experience forward from previous roles at Acciona, Abertis and Vinci.
- **Emeka Moneme.** Moneme joins Transurban as Vice President of Corporate Strategy and Innovation in North America where he is responsible for driving a forward-looking agenda including the cultivation of strategic partnerships and sustainable and next-generation mobility programs. Moneme brings 20 years of experience across the transportation, finance and real estate sectors in the Washington market with deep relationships across the infrastructure industry. He has served in senior leadership roles at the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) and Federal City Council.
- **Jeff Taylor:** Taylor joins Transurban as Vice President of Project Delivery, responsible for oversight of the company’s construction projects, its procurement team, as well as Health, Safety and Environmental initiatives. He brings over two decades of P3 design-build experience and has

delivered, or developed, \$5.5 billion in projects across five states, including the Design-Builder role on Transurban's Virginia's Express Lanes network with industry partner Fluor. He is also a registered Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Expansion of Transurban's North American executive team follows the on-time and on-budget delivery of an eight-mile extension of the Virginia Express Lanes network along I-395 last November. The toll road operator continues to advance construction and development of an additional 15 miles of Express Lanes extensions in the Greater Washington Area that will be open to travelers in 2022. Transurban also launched [GoToll](#) this year, an innovative new mobile app that allows drivers to pay for tolls on select roads across Virginia, including roads not operated by the company.
