

Roadside Tolling Upgrade Project



We have commenced a Roadside Tolling Upgrade project to improve some of our tolling equipment along the Logan and Gateway motorways. We appreciate your understanding whilst we conduct these important works.

About the project

We are enhancing our tolling technology and implementing a new system to ensure a more efficient process for our customers.

As part of this project, you'll see our tolling gantries replaced with new structures, and new roadside safety barriers installed.

The upgraded gantries are designed to be more durable and low maintenance, to ensure the consistent high quality of our roads.

No new tolling points will be installed as part of this project.

The upgrades will be undertaken to tolling gantries located along the Logan and Gateway motorways at the following locations:

- Sir Leo Hielscher Bridges north and southbound, near Lytton Road, Murarie
- Kuraby north and southbound, near Compton Road
- Loganlea east and westbound, near Loganlea Road
- Heathwood east and westbound, near Stapylton Road.
- Paradise Road, Larapinta, eastbound onramp and westbound off-ramp
- Loganlea westbound on-ramp and eastbound off-ramp, near Loganlea Road
- Stapylton Road, Heathwood, eastbound on-ramp and westbound off-ramp.

The existing gantries at Heathwood and Kuraby will be repurposed for advertising. The existing gantries at Paradise Road and Loganlea will be removed.

What to expect

We'll be working with the teams from McIlwain Civil Engineering and Kapsch TrafficCom to undertake the project.

Some inconvenience and noise is inevitable while we're working, and of course, we will do everything we can to avoid disrupting our neighbours and let you know when these disruptions are happening.

We'll also try to minimise the impacts to our customers - so you can still get where you're going - but some delays are likely.

Timing

The project commenced in April 2017 and we expect it to be completed in late 2018, weather permitting.

Work hours

We will mostly be working Monday to Friday, between 6am and 6pm, however we sometimes need to work during the night. If we do need to work at night it will be Sunday to Thursday, between 8pm and 5am, and we'll make sure local residents know when any night works are happening.

If there is bad weather or other unforeseen delays, our work will need to be moved to the next available shift.

How could this affect me?

If you use the Gateway or Logan motorways, you should expect changed road conditions and potential delays while works are in progress.

To keep everyone safe during the works, speed limits will be lowered, so make sure you're on the look out for reduced speeds.

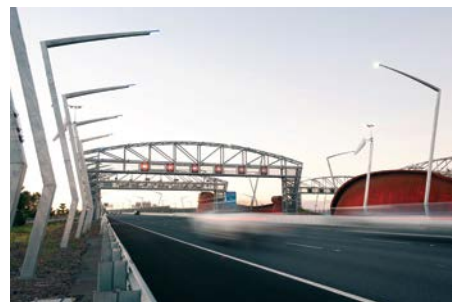

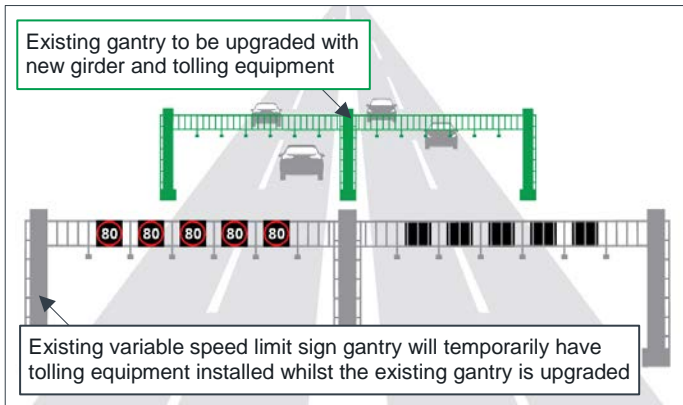

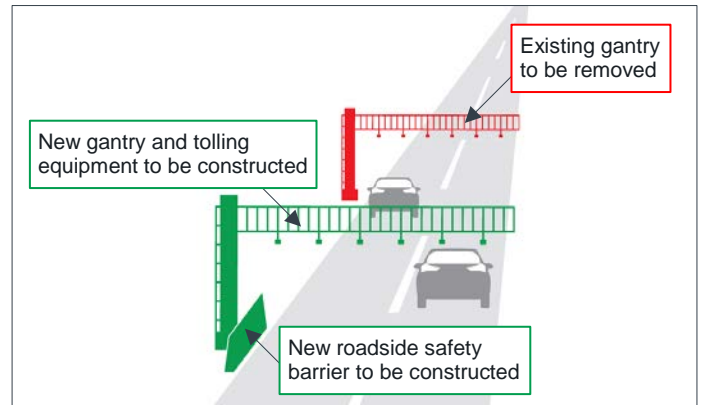
Mainline gantries

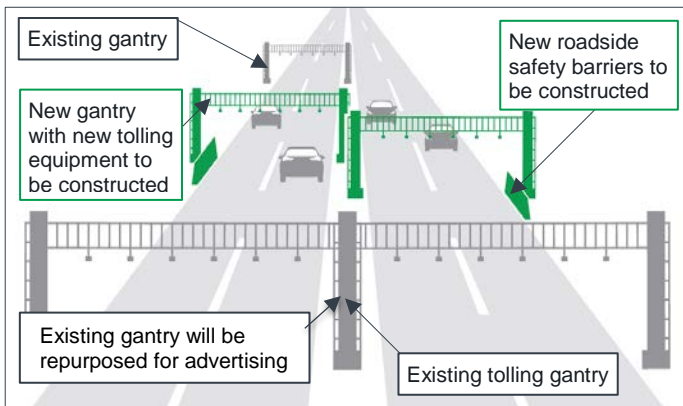


Ramp gantries

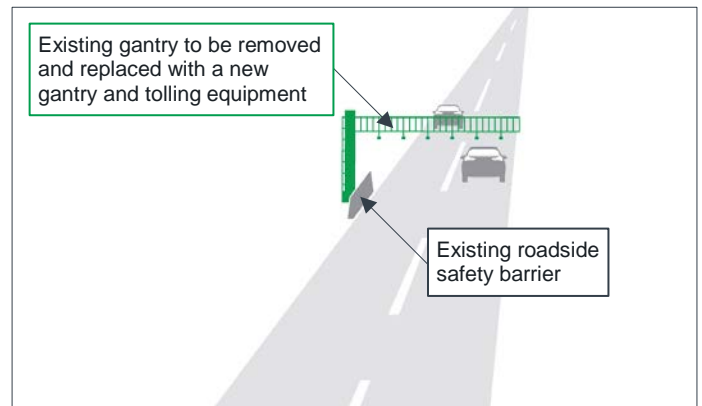
Paradise Road Eastbound on-ramp and Loganlea Eastbound off-ramp



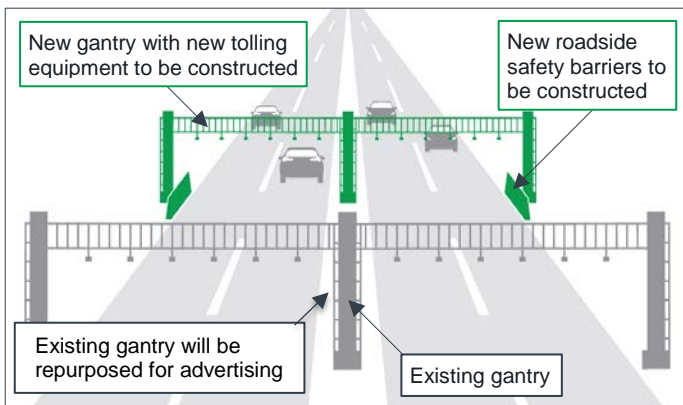
